

# A one-day workshop in Conveyancing Practice

## offered by the Centre for Conveyancing Practice

### Aim

To provide the following for students who have already prepared for the examination – final finishing and revision for the conveyancing exam through:

- a discussion of selected questions from previous exam papers and
- answers to any questions students may have.

### Who should attend it?

This course is ideal for people who -

- have already prepared for the examination, but who are still unsure about the drafting of documents and other aspects of the work;
- wrote the examination previously and was unsuccessful; or
- attended our course previously but did not write the examination.

### Nature of the course

This is a finishing course. It is a one-day workshop just before the examination which focuses on previous examination papers. The aim of the course is not to teach you conveyancing practice but to improve your drafting skills as a final preparation for the examination.

Prior knowledge, whether acquired through independent study of our Self-Study Deeds Course or by attending our Attendance Course in Conveyancing Practice, is required.

The workshop is an additional aid offered to students who are still uncertain and feel that they need more guidance.
